GALLERY AT SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN RIVERHEAD PRESENTS *THE LIBERATORS: SOLDIERS AT WORK*

The Lyceum Gallery located on the Riverhead Campus of Suffolk County Community College will present: *The Liberators: Soldiers at Work*, an exhibition that explores the scenes of the liberation of the survivors of the German concentration camps at the close of WWII.

In April of 1945 American troops began to liberate the camps. The exhibition will feature artifacts of the German surrender, concentration camp uniforms, a video of the time of this liberation and photographs depicting the scenes experienced by the liberating army upon arriving at the camps.

The exhibit has been organized by Steven Schrier, Executive Director of the Suffolk Center on the Holocaust, Diversity and Human Understanding (CHDHU). It will be on view from November 7 to December 19, with an opening reception on Wednesday, November 9, from 4:00 to 6:00 PM in the gallery. The Lyceum Gallery hours are Monday through Thursday from 11:00 AM to 6:00 PM and Friday from 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
